**Subject:** Agreement with Darrington School district for Prevention or Treatment

for Substance Use Disorders.

**Scope:** Motion 24-012 approves and agreement between the Health Department

and the Darrington School district to use Health Resources Services Administration (HRSA) <u>Rural Communities Opioid Response Program</u> (RCORP) grant funding to support prevention or treatment for substance

use disorders.

The Health Department is working with community partners to implement the grant's strategies and increase access to prevention, treatment and recovery services and support for individuals with opioid use disorder and their families. With this grant agreement, the Darrington School District will hire a term-limited behavioral health specialist to provide training to staff on evidence-based strategies to help with

children's self-regulation and reinforce pro-social behavior.

The grant not to exceed amount is \$155,000. Pursuant to SCC 3.014.140(1) contracts for intergovernmental services greater than

\$100,000 shall be approved by the County Council.
