Consideration

Proposed Motion 23-181 would authorize the Executive to sign the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) for the implementation of the Overdose Prevention Strategies at the Local Level project.

Background and Analysis

The mission of NACCHO is to improve the health of communities by strengthening and advocating for local health departments. NACCHO provides opportunities through the year for local health departments to apply for grant funding for various projects. The Snohomish County Health Department (previously Snohomish Health District (SDH)) has used NACCHO funding in the past. Motion 23-181 would authorize the executive to contract with NACCHO to develop overdose prevention strategies at the local level. This would result in receipt and expenditure of \$155,319 in grant funds in 2023. The full contractor agreement is an [attachment to the motion](#) and includes details on deliverables and timing. Some work is underway (as a continuance of previous SHD cooperation with NACCHO). July 31, 2023 is the completion date for the full scope of work.
