Direction needed on Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS)

- SEPA does not require the designation of a “preferred alternative” in a final EIS.
- We do however want to ensure that all potential actions the Council may take have environmental analysis completed.
- *Are there any additional proposals not included in the DEIS Alternatives 1-3 that the County Council would like additional analysis on?*
- Considering amendments outside the “bookends” of the draft EIS will lead to additional environmental review and jeopardize completing the 2024 Update on time.
