Subject: Interlocal Agreement with Tulalip Tribes for Water Line Relocation

Scope: The County, as part of the culvert replacement near 6304 19th Ave NE project, will be relocating the Tulalip Tribes Utilities waterline that is in county right-of-way. The project requires a single lane bypass road and the relocation of the Tulalip Tribes' waterline. An ILA is needed with the Tribe for the line relocation. The Tribes will be invoiced for costs in the scope of work.

Under the terms of the agreement, as described in Appendix A Scope of Work, the County will design and construct a 12-inch diameter, ductile iron waterline. This work will include drafting plans, specifications and engineering estimates, estimate/summary of quantities review, project bidding and award, contract construction, inspection, and construction management.

Authority Granted: Motion 26-219 approves and authorizes the County Executive, or his designee, to execute the interlocal agreement between Snohomish County and the Tulalip Tribes of Washington to relocate the Tribes' waterline for the culvert replacement project near 6304 19th Ave NE project, and further authorizes the County Executive to sign any documents or amendments related to the agreement.

Background: The County's Culvert Replacement project will replace a failing road culvert with a larger fish passage design culvert. Council approved a bid award recommendation¹ for the culvert replacement near 6304 19th Ave NE on March 18, 2026.
