Background Information

- November 21, 1988 The Snohomish County Council established the Snohomish County Conservation Futures Property Tax Fund as per Snohomish County Code Chapter 4.14.
- September 20, 1989 The Snohomish County Council, by amended Ordinance, established a Conservation Futures Program Advisory Board as per Snohomish County Code Chapter 4.14; duties include the review and recommendation of applications for projects to be funded with Conservation Futures Property Tax Funds.
- December 1, 2020 The Board directed staff to proceed with a grant round for consideration of funding recommendations by the first quarter of 2021. The estimated amount of funds available from the estimated Conservation Futures Property Tax through end of year 2021 totaled approximately four million four hundred ninety-seven thousand dollars (\$4,497,000.00), inclusive of the proposed return to fund balance for 3 projects that were not completed.
- February 26, 2021 The deadline date for grant application submittal, two (2) project sponsors submitted two (2) applications for Board consideration at its next scheduled meeting.
- March 24, 2021 The Board, at its public zoom meeting heard the presentations from project sponsors, deliberated and voted at the meeting. After careful deliberation the Board recommended fully funding the two (2) projects presented.
