BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

The Facilities & Fleet Department requests the use of a "piggyback" or "cooperative purchase" under SCC 3.04.220 utilizing a competitive bid issued and awarded by the Office of Washington State Department of Enterprise Services (DES). A Contract Usage Agreement between Snohomish County and DES authorizing cooperative purchases was approved by the County Council under Motion 24-232 and is currently in effect.

DES issued request for proposal number 06225 for Generator Maintenance, Repair, & Parts Services on August 18, 2025 (RFP). The bid contained 3 categories of generator capacity and was divided into six geographic regions. The RFP was awarded to two contractors for statewide coverage. This recommendation is for the highest scoring contractor. As a result of the RFP, DES executed Contract No. 06225 with Legacy Telecommunications LLC dated January 1, 2026 and has an ultimate expiration date of December 31, 2031 (DES Contract). The County has generators maintained by various departments and the use of the DES Contract is advantageous to and in the best interest of the County.

AWARD AUTHORITY:

This contract award recommendation is before the County Council for approval to award in accordance with Snohomish County Code section 3.04.120, "Formal sealed bidding," and Section 3.04.140(11) "Award, execution, by whom," which establish that the County Council has authority to approve the contracts for services subject to bidding requirements greater than \$50,000. The County Council approves this Award and authorizes the County Executive or designee to execute Agreements and subsequent Amendments for the products and services as defined above.
