Scope:

Snohomish County is seeking to enter into an interlocal agreement with the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS), under which \$315,000 will be provided to the County for the promotion of a public long term care insurance program called WA Cares¹.

Snohomish County is the regional Area Agency on Aging (AAA). Pursuant to the terms of the contract, AAAs implement an outreach plan to reach as many people as possible with information about WA Cares and inform audiences about key aspects of the program, including how contributions work, optional exemptions, using benefits, and covered services. AAAs will amplify statewide messaging on WA Cares and serve as a resource for WA Cares communications and outreach staff.

The AAA will work on provider network development. Contract deliverables include:

- A gap analysis of services and capacity.
- A timeline of provider outreach and engagement.
- Materials developed to engage providers.
- A list of provider training needs.

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<u>Background:</u> Wa Cares was created in 2019 with the passage of the Long-Term Services and Support Trust Act². Program benefits are anticipated to become available to eligible individuals in 2026. The program is financed by 0.58 percent payroll tax and covers up to \$36,500 for the care needs of eligible individuals.
