1. Amended Ordinance 23-074, relating to purchasing and contracting; amending Chapter 3.04 Snohomish County Code

4. Ordinance 23-083, approving and authorizing the County Executive 2023-0954 to execute an interlocal agreement by and between Snohomish Regional Fire & Rescue and Snohomish County for Evergreen State Fair Park fire protection and related services

Council Chair Mead opened the hearing and the clerk read the ordinance title into the record.

Deb Bell, Senior Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report explaining the proposed interlocal agreement for fire protection and emergency response services at the Evergreen State Fairgrounds. She noted that the County would pay Snohomish Regional Fire and Rescue \$41,253.14 for year-round fire protection and \$42,411.70 for fair services, for a total not to exceed \$83,664.84.
