A summary of the proposed ordinance is as follows:

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 22-064

GRANTING A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE AUTHORIZING LIMITED USE
OF THE PUBLIC ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN UNINCORPORATED
SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON TO T-MOBILE WEST, LLC

T-Mobile West, LLC, a Delaware corporation, has applied to Snohomish County, Washington, for a non-exclusive franchise to construct, maintain, operate, replace and repair telecommunications systems in, on, across, over, along, under, and/or through public rights-of-way within unincorporated Snohomish County.

If approved, proposed Ordinance No. 22-064 would grant said franchise to T-Mobile, LLC, subject to all of the terms and conditions contained in the ordinance.

If approved, the franchise would go into effect following enactment of the ordinance, acceptance by T-Mobile, LLC, provision of evidence of insurance, and payment of all applicable fees. The maximum term of the franchise would be twenty (20) years from the effective date.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may also consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
