Authority Granted: Authorizes the leasing of the Evergreen State Fair Park track facility to Washington Quarter Midget Association, subject to the terms and conditions as outlined in the lease and authorizes the Property Officer of the Department of Facilities Management to sign all documents necessary to effectuate the execution and implementation of the lease of the track facility, under SCC 4.46.211.

**Background:** Parks and Recreation, a division of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) manages a racetrack in the westerly portion of the Evergreen State Fair Park that is used for short track and go-cart racing.

In October 2024 the DCNR issued a Request for Proposals to lease the track facility at the Evergreen State Fair Park. DCNR has determined the winning proposal that will operate the track facility for the next 5-year term. Washington Quarter Midget Association was the successful respondent and has operated the track facility for the last 3-years for the purposes intended.

**Requested Action:** For Council to move the motion to GLS on January 29, 2025, for consideration.
