**Subject:** Intergovernmental Services Agreement between Snohomish County and the City of Lake Stevens for traffic control device and streetlight Maintenance

**Scope:** The proposed interlocal agreement would allow for a new agreement whereby the County will perform traffic signal, flashing crosswalk, beacon, radar speed sign, and streetlight maintenance services within the city boundary of Lake Stevens. Additional work may be performed at the County’s discretion using the Work Order Request process established in Section 5 of the contract. The City of Lake Stevens will reimburse all County costs incurred.

**Duration:** The proposed agreement will take effect upon mutual execution and shall remain in effect for an initial six (6) years. The Agreement may be extended or renewed for up to two (2) additional six (6) year terms.

**Authority Granted:** Motion 26-007 approves and authorizes the Snohomish County Executive, or designee, to sign the Agreement between Snohomish County and the City of Lake Stevens for Traffic Control Device and Street Light Maintenance

**Background:** Snohomish County and the City of Lake Stevens previously entered into a signal maintenance interlocal agreement. The most recent agreement was approved by Council on August 23, 2017, via Ordinance 2017-040.
