Solid waste is contained on the property, capped by a final cover system that is designed to minimize infiltration and erosion. The property is subject to post-closure requirements under WAS 173-350-400, which includes the owner or operator to maintain control and monitoring. Following the closure of a limited purpose landfill, the owner or operator must file an environmental covenant conforming to the procedures and requirements of the RCW 64.70.
