(AHA)

Scope: Amendment 3 to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (ILA) for the

Snohomish County Inter-Jurisdictional Alliance for Housing Affordability (AHA) allows the City of Monroe and the Town of Darrington to sign on

to the agreement.

The amendment also revises the process for approving future entrants to the ILA. Under the proposed process, governmental entities can sign on with the approval of the AHA Joint Board. Approval is decided by majority vote. Pursuant to the ILA, the AHA Joint Board is formed of one voting representative from each governmental entity. Currently, any new participants must be approved by all existing signatories to the ILA

via execution of an amendment to the ILA.

<u>Authority Granted:</u> Authorizes the County Executive to execute Amendment 3 to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (ILA) for the Snohomish County Inter-jurisdictional Alliance for Housing Affordability.

<u>Background:</u> On July 29, 2013, the County Council approved the County's participation in the AHA ILA in Motion 13-293<sup>1</sup>.

On June 16, 2014<sup>2</sup>, the County Council approved Amendment 1 (in Motion 14-241) approving the addition of City of Arlington to the ILA and Amendment 2 (in Motion 14-242) approving the addition of the City of Stanwood to the ILA.

<u>Requested Action:</u> Move to GLS on February 28, 2024, for Council to consider taking action.
