

Summany: The ordinance adjusts voling precinct boundaries due
to district boundary changes, annexations and population shifts as
required by state and local statute and in a manner that supports
efficient election administration. Snohomish County Elections is
required to examine and adjust precinct boundaries to account for
boundary changes following the federal decennial census,
annexations to cities/districts and population shifts on a nanual
basis. The total number of precincts resulting from these
adjustments is 869; acditional information is available in the 2025
Precinct Changes Report. All precinct boundary changes must
legally be completed at least 7 days prior to the annual candidate
filling period conducted in May.
At the Public Hearing, the Council imay consider amendments to
the proposed ordinance.
