Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 21-298, which would approve and authorize an Interagency Agreement with the Washington State Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC).

Background

In child dependency and termination cases, State law requires that the child be appointed a guardian ad litem or volunteer court appointed special advocate to advocate for the child's best interest during the case.¹ Currently 25 counties in the state of Washington, including Snohomish County, have court-based Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) Programs.

The Washington State Legislature approved a budget appropriation to Snohomish County for the purposes of funding two (2) court appointed advocates which is distributed by the AOC; funding is included for salary and benefits, allowable supplies, equipment, training and travel expenses.

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 21-298 authorizes:

1) The agreement with the AOC, including receipt of the grant funds and

2) The Snohomish County Executive or the CASA Program Division Manager to take all actions consistent with the agreement (bi-annual statistical reports, etc).

Duration: July 1, 2021-June 30, 2022 (termination allowed for convenience with five (5) days written notice.)

Fiscal Implications: \$211,286 (Exhibit A details the cost guidelines)

2021 Budget: YES

Future Budget Impacts: Agreement is renewed on an annual basis as appropriated by the state.
