

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 25-070
AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 22-046 TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL CAPITAL PROJECT TO THOSE CAPITAL PROJECTS FINANCED WITH PROCEEDS OF THE COUNTY'S LIMITED TAX GENERAL OBLIGATION

BONDS 2022

Summary: In Ordinance No. 22-046, the County authorized the issuance and sale of its limited tax general obligation bonds in an original aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$95,000,000 to provide long-term financing for the Arlington Public Works Operations Center Project and the SNO911 Project, and such bonds were issued as the County's Limited Tax General Obligation Bonds, 2022. Public Works has determined that it will not need all of the bond proceeds for the future Arlington Operations Center. Proposed Ordinance No. 25-070 would authorize the use of \$1,100,000 of bond proceeds that were issued for the Arlington Public Works Operations Center Project towards the Elliot Road Flood Reduction at Anderson Creek Project in the amount of \$425,000 and for the Cedarvale Loop Road Culvert Replacement Project in the amount of \$675,000.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.


