

AMENDING 26.20.120 OF THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE
RELATING TO STORM AND SURFACE WATER MANAGEMENT

Summary: The ordinance amends Snohomish County Code 26.20.120 Delinquent Service Charges to allow a motion for cancellation of uncollectible surface water charges to be brought to Council at any time during the course of lawful collections actions. At the hearing, Council may consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed ordinance.

Public Testimony: All interested persons may testify at the time and place indicated above or by remote participation. The chair of the council may choose to limit testimony to three minutes in the interest of accommodating all persons wishing to testify.
