Why would you like to serve on this board/commission? ___I have served for many decades on various boards and have a deep interest in both the recovery of our wild salmonid populations as well as a lifelong love of the salt. I've fished and boated longer than I can remember, was a liveaboard in Seattle for 7 years and logged almost 200 dives in the Salish Sea. I believe that my diverse background (that encompasses knowledge of the software industry, education, green construction, economic development, wild fish recovery science and Washington salmon and federal endangered species infrastructure/agencies) would allow me to add value as a member of this commission__



Please explain why you are a qualified candidate, including relevant professional experience, to serve on the board/commission. I am formerly: Executive Director of The Wild Steelhead Coalition; River Steward for the Native Fish Society on the Upper Yakima and participant in the Technical Work Group of the Skagit Watershed Council. I have collaborated with various tribes on wild fish restoration issues (i.e. received a grant from the Swinomish Tribe) and done many hours of field work (i.e. night snorkeling, habitat surveys, redd and young of year counts) with various public agencies (i.e. RFEGs, WDFW, DOE, NMFS, USFS). Before the pandemic I regularly attended many annual salmon/steelhead scientific and management conferences and am familiar with the life histories of our region's salmonids and the impact that our loss of functioning estuaries have had on our salmon populations. I've also had the opportunity to tour a recovered estuary and seen the positive results that long term investments in recovery can have (Salmon River, OR). But for all of that, I should point out that I am not a scientist—but someone trained in systems thinking with thousands of hours working in and leading groups. In addition to my background of the past dozen years in wild fish recovery, I have served for over 50 years on various boards and other groups representing the public interest. In addition, I am a successful entrepreneur and am knowledgeable in the area of green home construction.
