Background:	
The Board: Snohomish County Noxious Weed Control Board (the Board) is responsible advising on and assisting in local compliance with the state level weed control law	
(<u>Chapter 17.10 RCW</u>). The current form of the Board began with passage of Ordinance 87-	
102 in 1987. Under that ordinance, <u>SCC 3.42.090</u> divides Snohomish County into five	
Noxious Weed Control Districts of roughly equal area. There are six board members, five	
_	ne non-voting. The non-voting member is the county extension director or native. The remaining five members (all voting) each represent one of the
five weed control districts. Voting members serve terms of four years and may be	
reappointed f	for up to three full terms. (<u>SCC 3.42.010</u> and <u>RCW 17.10.050</u>)
The Nominee: Joshua Misenar is a resident of County Council District 2 and Noxious Weed	
Control District 3. His first appointment to the Board representing Weed District 3 was by	
Motion 19-254. Under that motion, his appointment was to a partial first term expiring on	
December 31, 2023. SCC 2.03.030(2) allows board members to continue serving until appointment of a successor. Motion 24-030 as received by the County Council would	
reappoint Joshua Misenar to a second full term expiring on December 31, 2028, or five	
years after the expiration of his first term.

Request: Move Motion 24-030 as amended to General Legislative Session on February 7, 2024, for consideration.

Amendment: Council staff suggests a verbal amendment to Motion 24-030 to revise the expiration date to be December 31, 2027, rather than 2028. This would make board member Misenar's second term end four years after the expiration of his first, consistent
