CHAPTER 2.47 SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE

Summary: Snohomish County Elections is required to examine and adjust precinct boundaries to account for boundary changes following the federal decennial census, annexations to cities/districts and population shifts on an annual basis. The ordinance adjusts voting precinct boundaries due to district boundary changes, annexations and population shifts as required by state and local statute and in a manner that supports efficient election administration. The total number of precincts resulting from these adjustments is 858.



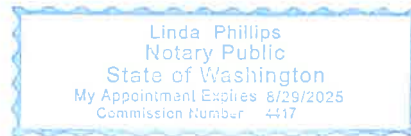
