Background

The 2022 Council-approved budget appropriated funding for Council-initiated, by-district projects. The Office of Recovery and Resilience has been working with Councilmembers and Council staff on identifying projects, and drafting the necessary agreements for funding.

Hope Creek Charitable Foundation operates the Mill Creek Community Food Bank, which provides food and hygiene supplies, and served over 70,000 how meals in 2021. That number is expected to increase 20-40% in 2022. This agreement will provide reimbursement for eligible expenses for food for low-income households and meal-related supplies, such as food storage containers, personal protective equipment, and cleaning supplies. The agreement runs through December 31, 2023, and reimbursement is not to exceed \$211,588.

Approval of the agreement between Snohomish County an Hope Creek Charitable Foundation for a reimbursement-based grant amount not to exceed \$211,588.
