Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 21-266, which would approve and authorize an agreement for professional services between the Public Defender's Association and the Prosecuting Attorney for the implementation and continuation of the LEAD program.

Background

In June 2020, the Council passed Motion 20-212¹ approving a \$1.69 million grant award from the Washington State Health Care Authority (HCA) to implement a Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion (LEAD) program² with the Cities of Everett and Lynnwood. The grant is a pass-through grant that provides funds for the LEAD Project Manager.

The Public Defender's Association initially provides funding for the LEAD Project Manager and is reimbursed by the Prosecuting Attorney's Office using the HCA funds.

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 21-266 authorizes the payment of \$130,000 to the Public Defender's Association as reimbursement for the Project Manager salary.

Duration: Upon execution to September 30, 2021

Fiscal Implications: None. Pass-through grant funding with no impact to the general fund.
