Re: Reappointment of Luisana Hernandez to the Law and Justice Council

With the support of District 2 County Councilmember Megan Dunn, I support the reappointment of Luisana Hernandez to the Snohomish County Law and Justice Council.

The Snohomish County Law and Justice Council serves as an advisory body to the County Council on issues relating to the law and justice system and was established in compliance with RCW 72.09.300.

Luisiana has been a valuable Law and Justice Council representative during her first term, providing professional experience and diverse connections in the community that enhance her contribution to the Law and Justice Council's work.

Per SCC 2.13.020, the representatives from each council district shall be selected in accordance with SCC 2.03, except that the executive shall consult with each councilmember regarding the applicants for the councilmember's district prior to submitting a nomination to council. I hereby urge the Council's confirmation of Luisana Hernandez to be reappointed to serve a second term as Representative of District 2 on the Snohomish County Law and Justice Council. This second term will expire 12/31/2028. Law and Justice Council community representatives are eligible to serve three consecutive terms.
