**Authority Granted:** n/a

**Background:** The Department of Emergency Management receives grant funds from [Homeland Security – Urban Area Security Initiative \(UASI\)](#). The Sheriff's Office obtained a quote from Goodrich Hoist to replace the hoist on one of their Search and Rescue Helicopters in 2024, which came back at \$225,000. After obtaining the quote, the Sheriff's Office requested funding from DEM's UASI grant and was awarded \$225,000 for the hoist. Between the time of the quote and now, that company has been acquired by Onboard Systems Hoist & Winch and they have indicated that they will not honor the prior quote. The new cost of the hoist replacement is \$329,044. To offset the difference between the UASI funds and the new cost of the hoist, the Sheriff's Office is requesting an Emergency Budget Appropriation in the amount of \$125,000 from Fund 141 Fund Balance to cover the remaining cost.

**Requested Action:** Set time and date for a public hearing.
