AUTHORIZING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF SNOHOMISH COUNTY AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SNOHOMISH COUNTY AND SOUTH SNOHOMISH COUNTY FIRE & RESCUE REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY FOR BENEFIT CHARGE COLLECTION SERVICES

Summary: The ordinance approves an Interlocal Agreement with South Snohomish County Fire & Rescue Regional Fire Authority for benefit charge collection services. The voters of South Snohomish County Fire & Rescue Regional Fire Authority approved a Fire Benefit Charge in the November 2020 election. For RCW, Fire Benefit Charges imposed by a Regional Fire Authority are collected and administered by the County Treasurer. The current administrative fee is \$1.03 per parcel and is based on 2023 actual costs. The County will continue to charge the current fee through April of 2025, and starting May 1, 2025, will charge the new fee of \$1.10 per parcel. The fee will be updated every two years thereafter.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.

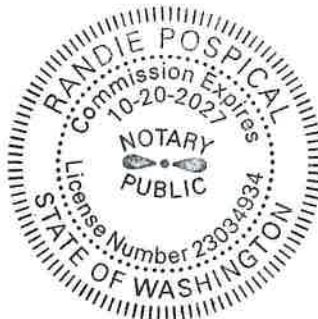
