Subject: Grant Agreement No. K5049 with Washington State Department of Agriculture for Capital Projects at the Evergreen State Fairground.

Scope: The Washington State Department of Agriculture has awarded a grant for health and safety improvements to the agricultural fairgrounds and facility. Grant Agreement No. K5049 in the amount of \$13,992.50 is to be used for replacing old chain link panels in the livestock area and adding high arch gates. This grant requires a 50% match, as such the County will be investing \$13,992.50 in the project for a total project amount of \$27,985.

Background: The Washington State Department of Agriculture awarded a grant to the County for capital improvement projects to make health and safety improvements to agricultural fairground or facilities to benefit participants and the fair-going public under RCW 15.76.165. The Evergreen State Fair Park’s budget and Grant Work Plan did not include funding for this project, and under the terms of the Grant Agreement, the County’s Fair Park Division will administer the grant funds and manage the project.
