APPROVING THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SNOHOMISH COUNTY
AND THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE RELATING TO SNOHOMISH COUNTY
AUTO THEFT TASK FORCE PARTICIPATION

WHEREAS, Snohomish County has applied for an Auto Theft Task Force grant contract with Washington Auto Theft Prevention Authority (WATPA), whereby Snohomish County shall use specified grant funds solely for a regional task force project consistent with the task force project proposal submitted to WATPA and which calls for the existence of a multi-jurisdictional task force; and

WHEREAS, the city of Marysville and the Washington State Patrol (hereinafter referred to as participating jurisdictions) support the aforementioned grant contract between Snohomish County and WATPA; and

WHEREAS, the participating jurisdictions desire to participate as members of the multi-jurisdictional task force with Snohomish County administering the task force project grant on their behalf; and

WHEREAS, the participating jurisdictions desire to enter into auto theft task force interlocal agreements with Snohomish County to enable Snohomish County to continue to be the receiver of any grant funds related to the task force project; and

WHEREAS, RCW 39.34 permits one or more public agencies to contract with any one or more other public agencies to perform any governmental service, activity or undertaking which each public agency is authorized by law to perform; and


WHEREAS, each of the participating jurisdictions represented herein are authorized to perform each service contemplated for it in the auto theft task force interlocal agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Executive and Council each consider it in the community's best interest to enter into the auto theft task force interlocal agreement for the purposes of attacking the demand and supply sides of auto theft, engaging in public education efforts aimed at preventing auto theft, assisting smaller agencies within Snohomish County with auto theft enforcement within their cities and towns, and providing enforcement training to police agencies throughout Snohomish County;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the County Council hereby approves the Interlocal Agreement between Snohomish County and the City of Marysville Relating to Snohomish County Auto Theft Task Force Participation and authorizes the County Executive to sign the necessary contracts.
