All other terms and conditions of the agreement will remain in full force and effect.

The City of Arlington designates a Naloxone Liaison to track naloxone supplies and report data on the use and storage of the medication to the Snohomish County Health Department.

**Background:** RCW 69.41.095<sup>1</sup> establishes that any person or "entity" (e.g., police department, homeless shelter) can obtain, possess, and administer naloxone.

On September 23, 2022, the Snohomish Health District entered into the "Agreement for Distribution and Acceptance of Naloxone" with the City of Arlington.

On October 26, 2022, Council approved Ordinance 22-061<sup>2</sup> creating the Health Department, fund, and other operational aspects of the new department. On the same day, Council passed Ordinance 22-060<sup>3</sup> approving an Interlocal Agreement with the Health District, transferring its employees, operations, powers, duties, enforcement, and assets to the County.
