Section 1. The Council finds that pursuant to the authority of SCC 2.47.040(2), the Auditor made those adjustments to precinct boundaries since April 14, 2021, that are set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
Section 2. Snohomish County Code Section 2.47.030, last amended by Ordinance 21-016 on April 14, 2021, is amended to read:

2.47.030 Precincts adopted.

(1) The adopted voting precinct boundaries for the county are those set forth in the precinct map books maintained on file with the clerk of the council and the Snohomish County Auditor's Office, subject to revision from time to time in accordance with SCC 2.47.040.

(2) To implement boundary changes resulting from redistricting following the federal decennial census and to implement changes that are necessary to maintain conformance with applicable laws in accordance with SCC 2.47.040, the precinct boundaries adopted by subsection (1) are revised cumulatively as set forth in the following documents:

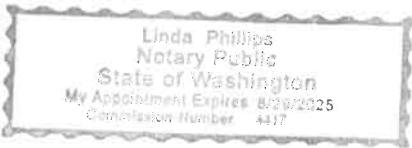

AMENDING CHAPTER 2.47 SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE;
