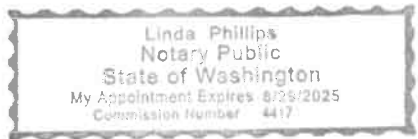

RELATING TO THE SUPERIOR COURT, INCREASING THE NUMBER OF SUPERIOR COURT COMMISSIONERS, AND AMENDING CHAPTER 2.14 SCC

Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 2.14.010, last amended by Ordinance 05-044 on June 29, 2006, is amended to read:

2.14.010 Creation of ((Position)) Positions.

(1) Pursuant to Washington Constitution, Article IV, Section 23, there is created within the superior court of Snohomish county three positions of court commissioner.

(2) Pursuant to RCW 26.12.050, ((and)) 71.05.135, and 10.14.045 there is created within the superior court of Snohomish county ((two)) three positions of family court/ mental health/protection order commissioner.

At the hearing, Council may consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed ordinance.
