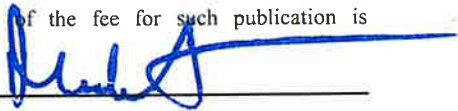

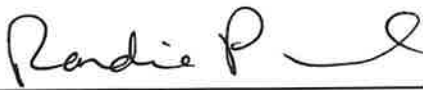

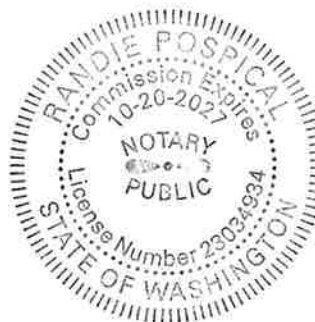

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 26-028
APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
SNOHOMISH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF STANWOOD FOR
FLOOD RISK MITIGATION

Summary: The Ordinance approves an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with the City of Stanwood to oversee the management of a capital project to repair approximately 1000 linear yards of a flood-damaged levee and a site in need of subsurface remediation near downtown Stanwood. The damaged portion of the levee, owned and maintained by Diking District 7, currently protects from flood risk approximately 2200 acres of agricultural land, the City of Stanwood, surrounding communities and businesses, and State Highway 532. The County will fund certain emergency repairs as described in the agreement and will provide up to \$1,750,000 in funds in support of the project. The term of the ILA is through December 31, 2026.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
