GRANTING A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE AUTHORIZING LIMITED
USE OF THE PUBLIC ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN PORTIONS OF
SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON TO THE CITY OF GOLD BAR

The City of Gold Bar, a Washington municipal corporation, has applied to Snohomish County, Washington, for a non-exclusive franchise to construct, maintain, operate, replace and repair water systems in, on, across, over, along, under, and/or through public rights-of-way within the following portions of unincorporated Snohomish County:

If approved, proposed Ordinance No.24-053 would grant said franchise to the City of Gold Bar, subject to all of the terms and conditions contained in the ordinance.

If approved, the franchise would go into effect following enactment of the ordinance, acceptance by the City of Gold Bar, provision of evidence of insurance, and payment of all applicable fees. The maximum term of the franchise would be twenty (20) years from the effective date.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
