### OVERVIEW

- The Human Services Department is required to submit quarterly reports to the Snohomish County Council regarding expenditures and services for three councilmanic sales tax funds.
- The first, the Chemical Dependency and Mental Health Sales Tax is authorized under RCW 82.14.460. These funds may be used for capital costs, operations, and delivery of chemical dependency and mental health treatment and services, including housing, and for therapeutic court programs and services. This program has been in existence in Snohomish County since 2008. Programming began in 2009 with the majority of programming beginning in 2010.
- The second, the Affordable Housing Sales Tax is authorized under RCW 82.14.540. These funds have been coupled with the Affordable Housing and Behavioral Health Sales Tax authorized under RCW 82.14.530. Taken together, these second and third funds may be used for capital, operating and maintenance, and services costs associated with affordable housing, including emergency housing and permanent supportive housing, and behavioral health facilities. The 5year investment plan for these funds was approved by Snohomish County Council on December 13, 2023.
