AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SNOHOMISH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF LAKE STEVENS FOR LAKE MANAGEMENT AND WATER QUALITY SERVICES

WHEREAS, Snohomish County (the "County") and the City of Lake Stevens (the "City") have entered into prior interlocal agreements for lake monitoring, management and water quality services; and

WHEREAS, Lake Stevens lies within the boundaries of the City; and

WHEREAS, Lake Stevens is an important water resource for the City which provides opportunities for swimming, boating, fishing and aesthetic enjoyment; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County recognize the importance of performing certain water quality monitoring services at Lake Stevens; and

WHEREAS, the City does not have the staff or resources to monitor water quality at Lake Stevens; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to retain the services of the County to perform certain water quality monitoring at Lake Stevens and the County has the staff and resources to perform said services; and

WHEREAS, the City approved the Agreement on April 29, 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Snohomish County Council approves and authorizes the County Executive to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Lake Stevens in the amount of \$175,000 from the date the Intergovernmental Agreeent is executed, to December 31, 2026 and any additional amendments thereto.
