Authority Granted: Approve and authorize the Executive to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Interlocal Agreement between Snohomish County and the City of Everett for the Lion's Park Skate DOT project, under County Charter 1.30.

Background: The 2023 Adopted Budget included \$750,000 for REET II funds, collected under RCW 82.46, to be split equally between five council districts for Council/City Partnership Projects. In 2023, Council identified various projects for inclusion, including the City of Everett's Lion's Park Skate DOT project. Snohomish County agreed to provide eighty thousand (\$80,000) of REET II funds in support of the project.

Requested Action: For Council to move the motion to GLS on September 10, 2025, for consideration.
