Subject: Conditioned 2023 OPD Conflict Attorney Fees

Scope: Release \$150,000 conditioned in the 2023 budget for expenditure by the

Office of Public Defense for Conflict Felony Attorney Fees.

<u>Background:</u> During the 2023 Budget process, \$300,000 was added to the total appropriation for Conflict Felony Attorney Fees by Council. Of that, \$150,000 was conditioned through Budget Condition #4. Under the condition, OPD was to submit a motion requesting a release of the funds once they have expended at least 70% of their total appropriation.

At this time, the <u>Office of Public Defense has not met the conditions</u>. The office has expended \$396,989.57 of their \$1,004,183 appropriation (or 39.5%). They have earmarked another \$562,365.01 (or 56%). Earmarked funds mean a PO has been submitted and OPD has been approved administratively to expend the funds, but *they haven't actually incurred and/or paid the cost yet*.

Requested Action: Should Council choose to move the motion forward, requested action is to move to GLS on October 4th for consideration.
