6 APPROVING THE PUBLIC FACILITY DISTRICT OF LYNNWOOD  
7 INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT CLFR-036b

9 WHEREAS, Snohomish County has secured Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery  
10 (CLFR) grant funds under the federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA); and

11  
12 WHEREAS, the Executive Office of Snohomish County created the Office of  
13 Recovery & Resilience (ORR) to aid in the distribution of the ARPA funds; and

14  
15 WHEREAS, both the County and the Public Facility District (PFD) of Lynnwood  
16 are public agencies under chapter 39.34 RCW; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, RCW 36.01.085 states that economic development programs are a  
19 public purpose for counties in Washington state; and

20  
21 WHEREAS, RCW 35.57.020 authorizes the PFD to acquire, own, remodel,  
22 maintain, equip, repair, finance, and operate regional centers; and

23  
24 WHEREAS, the County recognizes the PFD of Lynnwood is important to  
25 economic development in Snohomish County; and

27 WHEREAS, the County desires to provide the PFD of Lynnwood with **\$437,500**  
28 as a subrecipient of federal funds to provide government services in compliance with  
29 chapter 53.04 RCW;

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

33 **Section 1.** The Snohomish County Council approves the PFD of Lynnwood  
34 Interlocal Agreement (for the period January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2023) in the  
35 amount of \$437,500 and authorizes the County Executive to sign the Agreement.
