

Snohomish County Community Services Advisory Council Appointment Matrix

The Community Services Advisory Council was established by the County Council in 1986, with the purpose of 'advising the county executive and the county council, through the Snohomish County Human Services Department, on all matters relating to the causes of poverty and to a reduction in the effects of poverty.'¹ The Advisory Council shall consist of at least 12 and not more than 24 members.¹ The Advisory Council shall make efforts to have each County Council legislative district represented through membership, with at least one-third of the members representative of low-income individuals and families, and the balance drawn from individuals in the private sector and public elected officials or their representatives.² The sectors shall be termed Low-Income Representative, Community Representative, and Elected Official Representative. Members serve four-year terms and may not serve more than two consecutive terms. Appointments are recommended by the Executive and confirmed by the County Council.
