Consideration

Proposed Motion 21-219 would authorize the County Executive to accept an Emergency Management Performance Grant

Background

Snohomish County is eligible for a grant of \$141,889 in federal funds for the expansion of emergency management communications that originates with the Department of Homeland Security and passes through the Washington State Military Department – Emergency Management Division. The grant requires a 100% match of local funds. Snohomish County Department of Emergency Management proposes to match through General Fund expenditures for salary and benefits of non-grant funded staff.
