A summary of the proposed ordinance is as follows:

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 22-063

GRANTING A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE AUTHORIZING LIMITED USE OF THE  
PUBLIC ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN PORTIONS OF SNOHOMISH COUNTY,  
WASHINGTON TO INTERMOUNTAIN INFRASTRUCTURE GROUP, LLC.

Intermountain Infrastructure Group, LLC, a special purpose district, has applied to Snohomish County, Washington, for a non-exclusive franchise to construct, maintain, operate, replace and repair telecommunication systems in, on, across, over, along, under, and/or through public rights-of-way within the following portions of unincorporated Snohomish County:

If approved, proposed Ordinance No. 22-063 would grant said franchise to Intermountain Infrastructure Group, LLC, subject to all of the terms and conditions contained in the ordinance.

If approved, the franchise would go into effect following enactment of the ordinance, acceptance by Intermountain Infrastructure Group, LLC, provision of evidence of insurance, and payment of all applicable fees. The maximum term of the franchise would be twenty (20) years from the effective date.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may also consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.




