Consideration:

Approve an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Brier for Law Enforcement Services.

Background:

RCW 39.34.085 authorizes two or more public entities to contract with each other to perform functions which each may individually perform provided that the agreement be authorized by the governing body. Snohomish County has provided law enforcement services to various jurisdictions within Snohomish County for well over 20 years.

The City of Brier has requested supplemental law enforcement services while they try to hire police officers.

Current Proposal:

Scope: Motion 23-274 authorizes an ILA between the County and the City of Brier. Details of the supplemental services are:

- Patrol Services:

	Sunday	Monday	Tuesday	Wednesday	Thursday	Friday	Saturday
Proactive	6:00pm - 2:00am						
Reactive	2:00am - 6:00am						

- *Proactive:* All levels of 911 calls
 - If County is unable to staff during these hours, they will respond to priority 1 and 2 calls and bill on a call for service basis.
 - *Reactive:* Priority 1, 2, and 3 calls on a call for service basis.
 - County will provide special services
 - County will not provide support services.
 - City is responsible for data entry and processing/maintaining evidence and property collection.
- A Sheriff Lieutenant will act as an interim administrative liaison officer and coordinate service delivery with the city’s Chief of Police.

Duration: May 21, 2023 – December 31, 2023. May be terminated with 30 days written notice.
