NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on November 29, 2023, the Snohomish County Council approved Ordinance No. 23-109.

ORDINANCE NO. 23-109

RELATING TO THE 2023 BUDGET; MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION  
IN EQUIPMENT RENTAL AND REVOLVING FUND 502 TO PROVIDE  
EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT

**Summary:** The supply chain interruptions and delays since COVID have made delivery of critical County assets unpredictable, some as much as a three-year delay. In 2023, supply chain delays are beginning to ease up, and a large backlog of long delayed vehicles and equipment is now being delivered, which could not have been reasonably foreseen prior to the adoption of the 2023 budget. The ordinance makes an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$3,248,977 in the ER&R Fund for additional expenditure authority for new vehicles and equipment that were purchased in previous year's budget.


