I am pleased to recommend the appointment of Corrine Lund to serve an initial three-year term on the Snohomish County Developmental Disabilities Citizen Advisory Board.

Corrine Lund resides in Council District 5. Corrine Lund holds a Bachelor of Science in Nursing and has served as a nurse for 23 years including positions at Providence, Swedish Edmonds and University of Washington. Corrine Lund is the parent of an individual with a developmental disability and has experience navigating disability systems and services in three states, Washington, Hawaii and California.

The Developmental Disabilities Citizen Advisory Board is comprised of citizens who serve in an advisory capacity to the Developmental Disability (DD) staff of the Snohomish County Human Services Department. The Board meets monthly and is comprised of up to 15 members drawing from all areas of the county and a range of backgrounds, including family members, individuals with developmental disabilities, professionals, and advocates.
