Consideration:

Motion 22-308 would approve the 2022 contract with the International Lumberjack Show for them to perform at the Evergreen State Fair.

Background:

The International Lumberjack Show has put on the lumberjack show at the Evergreen State Fair annually for over 30 years, except for 2020 due to the Fair being canceled. Each day the fair operates there are three shows, with the exception of the last day of the Fair when there are only two. The most recent contract was in 2021 which was approved by Council via Motion 21-263 for a total amount of \$33,000.

Current Proposal:

Scope: The International Lumberjack Show will provide three shows each day of the Fair, except for September 5th where they will perform twice. Each show must contain: log rolling; tree climbing; chopping; sawing; axe throwing; and chair carving. The Scope and Terms can be found on page one of the contract, along with minimum show requirements and other contractor responsibilities.

Duration: Contract includes three shows per day between August 25 and September 5, 2021, but excludes Wednesday August 31st, as the Fair is closed that day.
