PROPOSED ORDINANCE 23-016

APPROVING AGREEMENT WITH WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR  
INFORMATION SHARING FOR THE EXCHANGE OF IMMUNIZATION DATA

WHEREAS, the Snohomish Health District was integrated into Snohomish County effective December 31, 2022, and now operates as the Snohomish County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, prior to its integration into Snohomish County, the Snohomish Health District entered into an information sharing agreement with the Washington State Department of Health for the exchange of immunization data; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Health and the Snohomish County Health Department wish to continue this partnership; and

WHEREAS, the Health Department shall continue to update vaccination records for any vaccines provided by Department staff; and

WHEREAS, the County Council held a public hearing on \_\_\_\_\_, 2023, to consider approving an information sharing agreement with the Washington State Department of Health for the exchange of immunization data and to authorize the Snohomish County Executive to enter into such agreement in substantially the form attached as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The County Council hereby adopts the foregoing recitals as findings of fact and conclusions as if set forth in full herein.

Section 2. The County Council hereby approves and authorizes the County Executive, or designee, to execute the interagency agreement between Snohomish County and the Washington State Department of Health for exchange of immunization data in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed ordinance.




