Subject: State Home Energy Assistance Program (SHEAP) Contract

Scope: Human Services is seeking to contract with the Washington State

Department of Commerce to implement the State Home Energy

Assistance Program (SHEAP). The grant total is \$1,719,256.

SHEAP funds are designed to address rising home energy costs by providing assistance with a portion of a household's heating bill. The services provided under SHEAP are the similar those funded by the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). LIHEAP funds are awarded to households at 150% of the Federal Poverty Line and SHEAP may be awarded to households earning 80% of county area median

income.

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<u>Authority Granted:</u> Motion 24-260 approves and authorizes the County Executive to sign the State Home Energy Assistance Program (SHEAP) contract in the amount of \$1,719,256 and any additional amendments.

<u>Background:</u> The State Home Energy Assistance Program is supported with funding from Washington's Climate Commitment Act (SB 5126¹ from 2021-2022).

On March 27, 2024, Council passed Motion 24-116², approving execution of a LIHEAP contract with the Washington State Department of Commerce in the amount of \$3,583,119.
