Consideration:

Confirm the appointment of Michael Adams to the Sno-Isle Libraries Board of Trustees.

Background:

Snohomish County Code 2.28 established the Inter-County Rural Library District of Island and Snohomish Counties (Sno-Isle Libraries). County code dictates that the library district is governed by a seven-member board and that the board be comprised of two trustees from Island County and five trustees from Snohomish County.

Rico Tessandore completes his second term on December 31, 2021, leaving a vacancy for one of the five Snohomish County resident positions. Out of 32 applicants and ten interviews, the Board of Trustees recommends the appointment of Michael Adams to the Sno-Isle Libraries Board of Trustees. Mr. Adams is a resident of Granite Falls, social worker, founder and executive of a non-profit called Change the Narrative, and actively engaged in the community.

Current Proposal:

The proposed motion requests Council's confirmation of Michael Adams as a Snohomish County Trustee to the Sno-Isle Libraries Board of Trustees for a seven-year term starting January 1, 2021 and ending January 1, 2028.
