**Subject:** Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (CLFR) – Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 26 – Sky Valley

**Scope:** This Ordinance would approve an Interlocal Agreement with the Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 26 – Sky Valley, herein Fire District, under which the Fire District would receive \$500,000 of CLFR funds for their Sky Valley Fire District Training Facility Capital Project. The Fire District purchased the property in 2015 and is working to relocate, upgrade, and expand the training facility. The ILA stipulates construction must be complete by June 30, 2026 and all requests for reimbursement be in to the County by September 30, 2026. Additional project information can be found in Exhibit B of the ILA.

**Authority Granted:** Authorizes the Executive to execute the agreement.

**Background:** Snohomish County received [Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery](#) (CLFR) grant funds under the [American Rescue Plan Act](#) (ARPA) which was passed by Congress in 2021. Guidelines for these funds allow the County to transfer funds to a special purpose district of state or local government as a subrecipient. Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 26 – Sky Valley is a public agency under chapter 39.34 RCW and is therefore eligible to receive a portion of the CLFR funds received by the County.
