Authority Granted:

1. Authorization to the County Executive to sign the grant award agreement.
2. Authorization to the Airport Director to approve any amendments not to exceed 15% of the original grant amount.

Background:

Paine Field, Snohomish County’s Airport received FAA Airport Improvement Program (AIP) Grant Offer 3-53-0028-068-2025 and is being provided to the Airport to reconstruct the asphalt pavement of the eastern half of Taxiway Echo with concrete, as well as rehabilitate the asphalt pavement of Taxiway Lima via mill & overlay, in order to preserve the useful life of these pavements.

The project will be 95% funded by the grant in the amount of \$8,500,000. There is a required 5% match and will be provided from the Airport Fund. This is anticipated not to exceed \$447,369.

The Executive must execute the grant, followed (and not preceded) by the attorney’s certification, no later than February 24, 2025, for the grant to be valid.
