PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 23-134

GRANTING A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE AUTHORIZING LIMITED
USE OF THE PUBLIC ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN PORTIONS OF
UNINCORPORATED SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON TO
NORTHSHORE UTILITY DISTRICT

Northshore Utility District, a Washington special purpose district, has applied to Snohomish County, Washington, for a non-exclusive franchise to construct, maintain, operate, replace and repair water and sewer systems in, on, across, over, along, under, and/or through public rights-of-way within the following portions of unincorporated Snohomish County:

<u>Township</u>	<u>Range</u>	<u>Sections</u>
Twp. 27N	Rge. 4E W.M.	Sects. 35

If approved, proposed Ordinance No. 23-134 would grant said franchise to Northshore Utility District, subject to all of the terms and conditions contained in the ordinance.

If approved, the franchise would go into effect following enactment of the ordinance, acceptance by Northshore Utility District, provision of evidence of insurance, and payment of all applicable fees. The maximum term of the franchise would be twenty (20) years from the effective date.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.


